## COLORADO COUNTY COURTHOUSE REPORT

Eight individuals were sentenced in Colorado County District Court on March 8. They included:

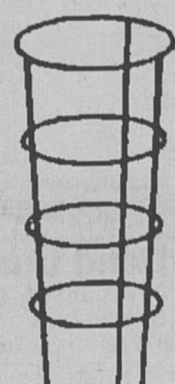
