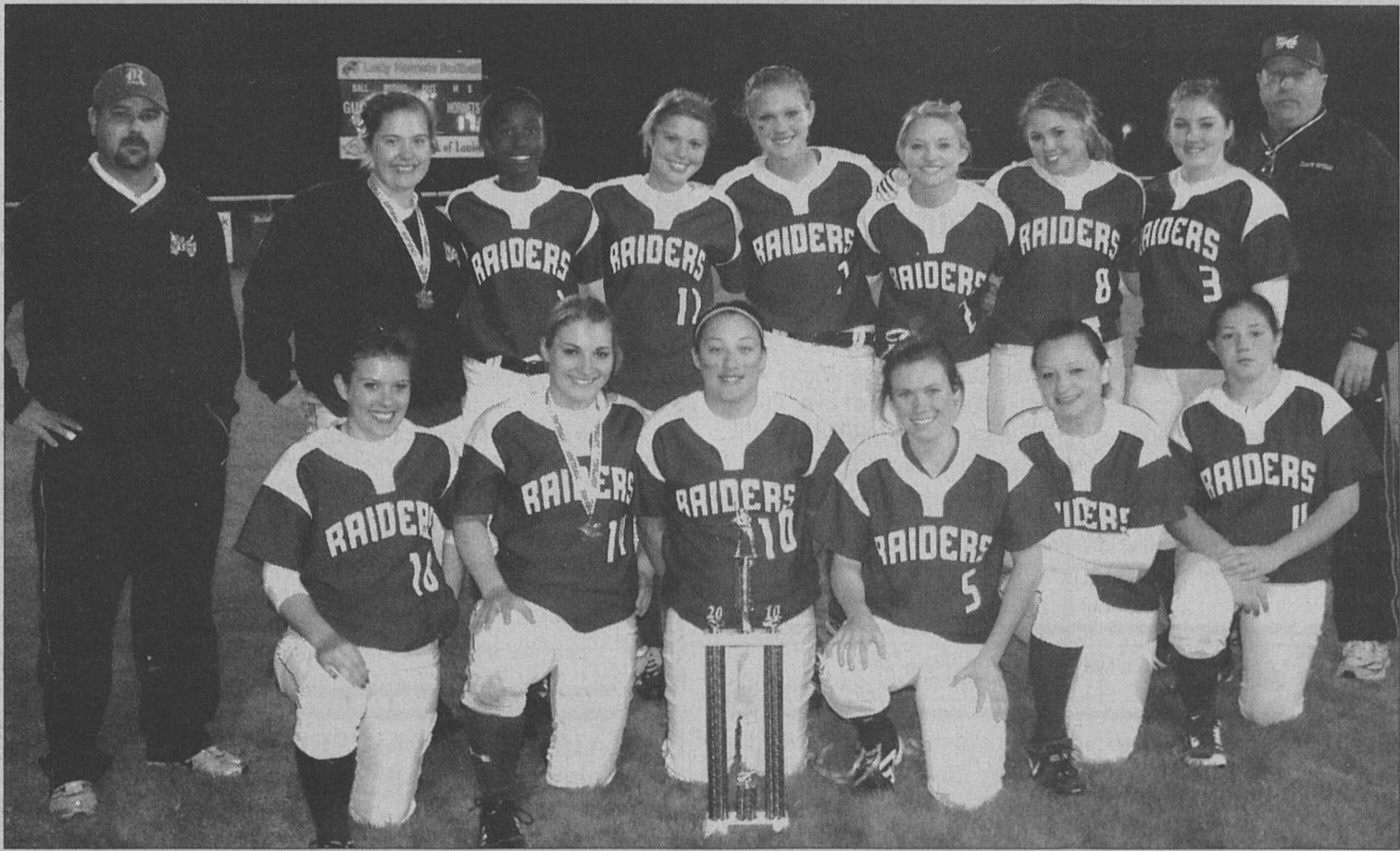

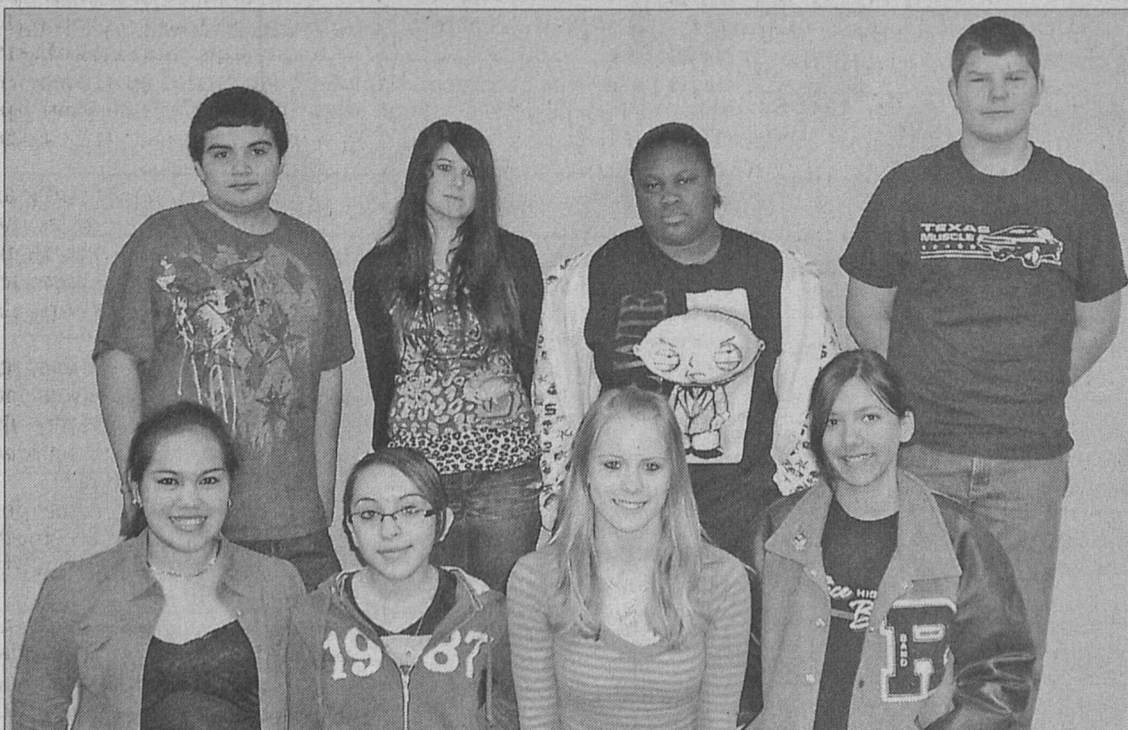
man), and Zachary Yanez (alto saxophone, senior).
