Voters who voted in the Democratic primary are not eligible to vote in the Republican runoff.

Early Voting will start on Monday April 5 through Friday April 9 at the Colorado County Courthouse from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

All twelve voting locations will be used on Election Day.

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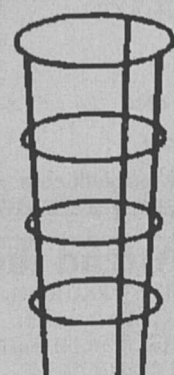
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
