Life Guard Training Planned Here

A registration meeting will be held on Thursday, April 8, 2010 at the Eagle Pool for all students interested in taking either the Red Cross Lifeguarding course or the renewal course.

Current lifeguards wanting to renew their CPR and/or lifeguard certificates as well as new students will meet at 7 p.m. Course schedules will be discussed at this meeting.

Prerequisites for new students:

1. Must be fifteen years of age or older by May 15th;
2. Swim front crawl for twenty yards, surface dive to ten feet and retrieve a ten pound object and swim back to starting point within

1 minute, 40 seconds; and
3. Swim three hundred yards continuously using the front crawl with rhythmic breathing and a stabilizing, propellant kick, and the breaststroke.

Students must attend all classes, and pass all written and skills tests with a score of 80 or better.

Course fees for new students are \$140.00 (\$90.00 to Am. Red Cross for textbooks, pocket mask, valve, bandage kit, equipment usage fee and administrative fees); and, \$50.00 to local Red Cross for pool and instructor supplies.) Course fees for lifeguard renewals are \$50.00 and CPR renewals are \$40.00

Catherine Pettus, false report to police officer/law enforcement employee. Sentenced to three days in jail, fined \$250 plus court costs.

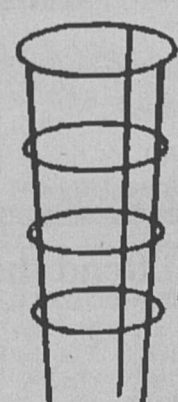
Brent Allen Roberts, driving while intoxicated. Sentenced to 10 days in jail, fined \$1,500 plus court costs, six month's driver's license suspension.
