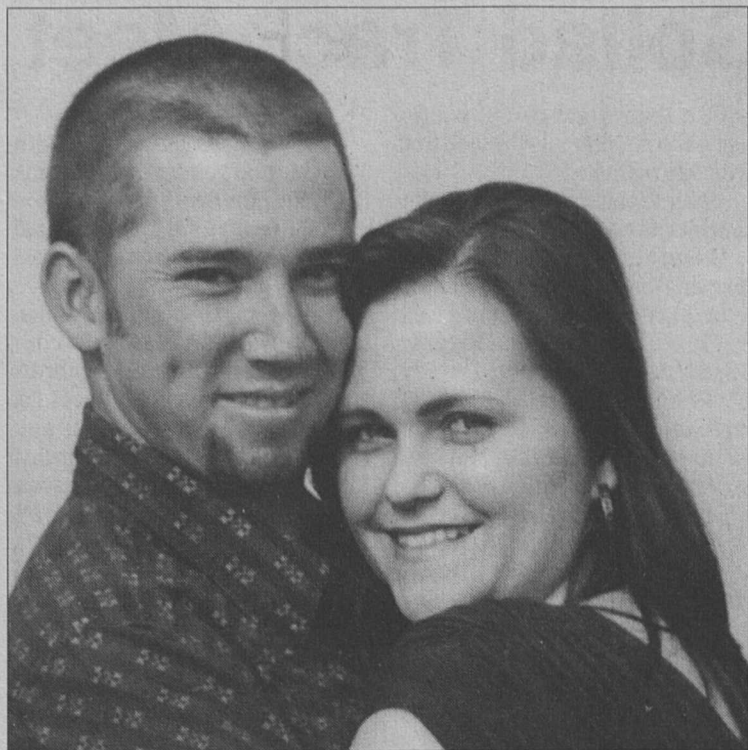




Drlik, Ray Announce Engagement

The Youth Annual will be held Sunday May 2nd at the 11:30 a.m. service.

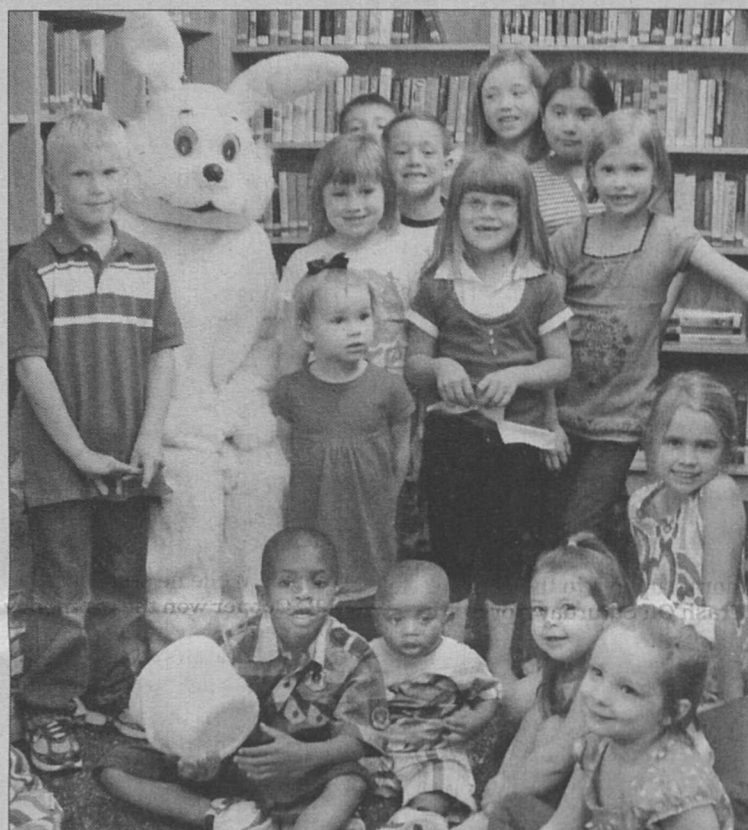
Revival messenger will be Rev. Jerrell Barron, Pastor of Pleasant Union MBC in Schulenburg and El Campo High School Athletic Coach.

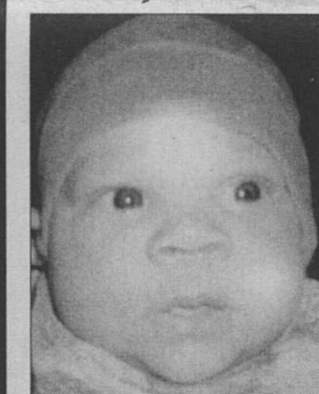

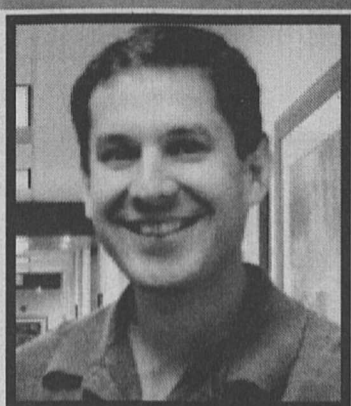

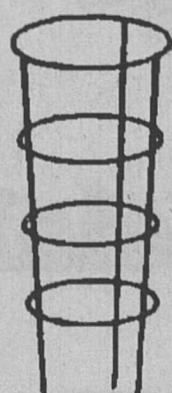
