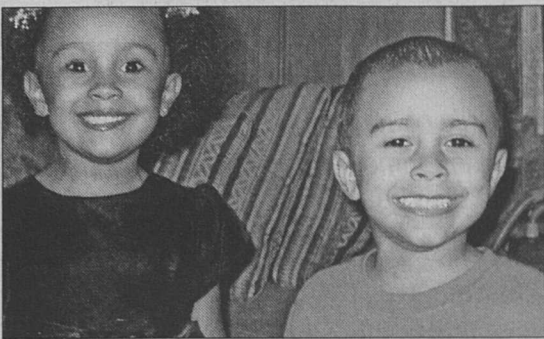


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Lady Raiders Win Goliad Track Meet

The Rice Raiders and Lady Raiders participated in the Goliad Relays held on Thursday, April 8.

The Lady Raider Varsity track team won the event taking first place with 132 total team points.

They were followed close behind by Calhoun with 129 points.

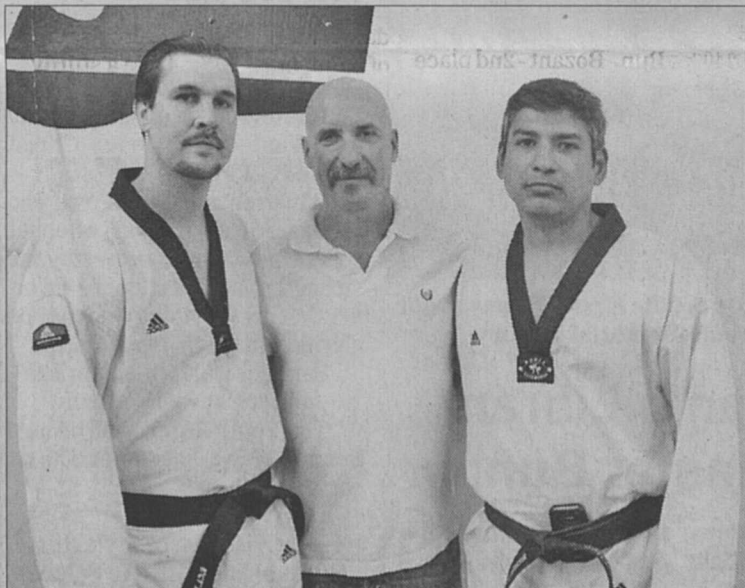
The Ladies outcome wasn't as good against the Ladies from East Bernard. Rice lost to them on April 9, 2-6.
