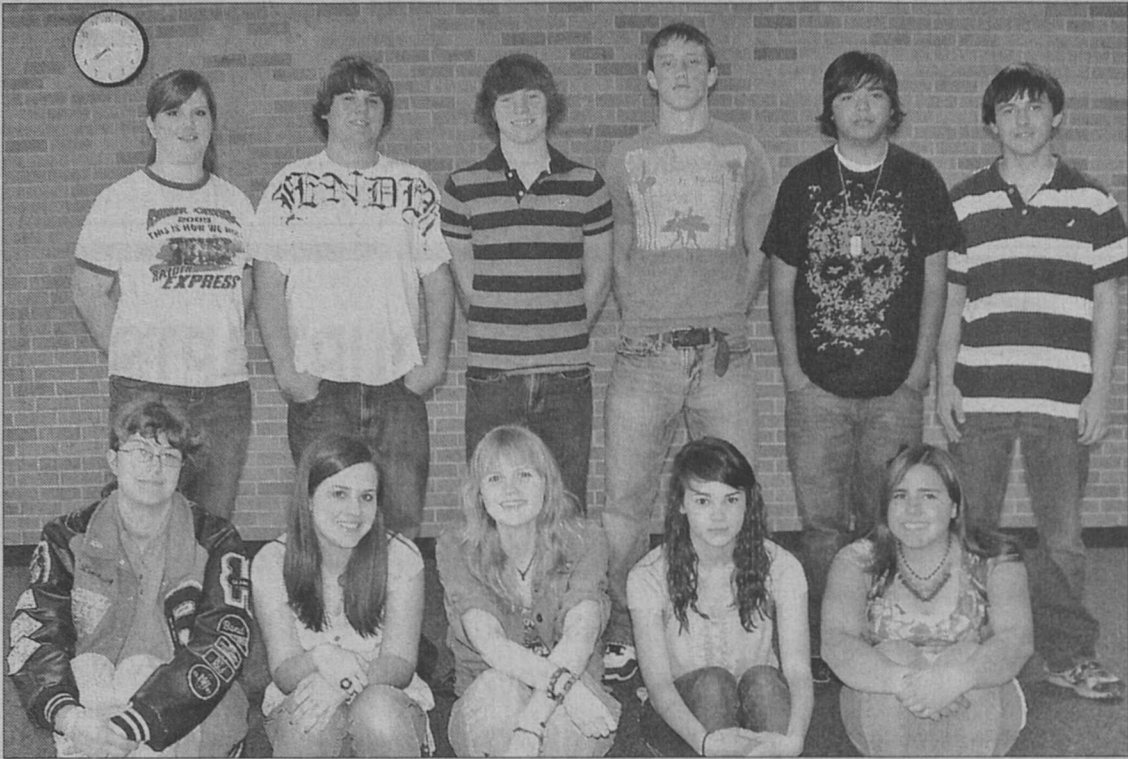




Perfect Attendance Award Winners

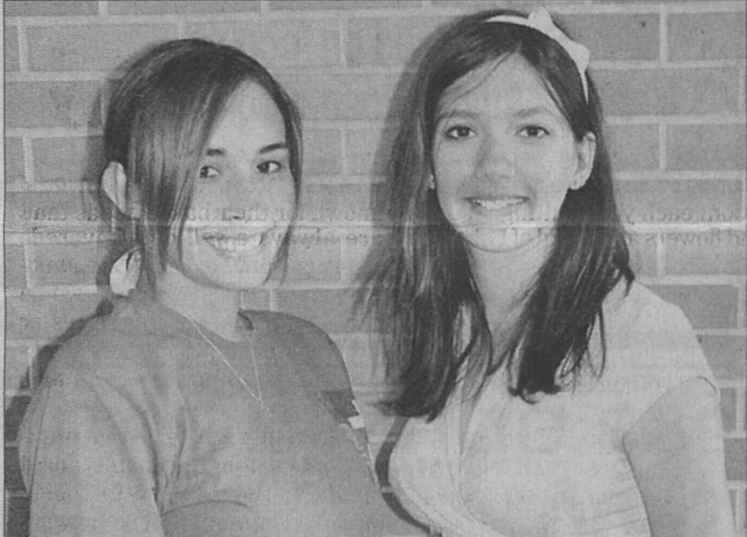

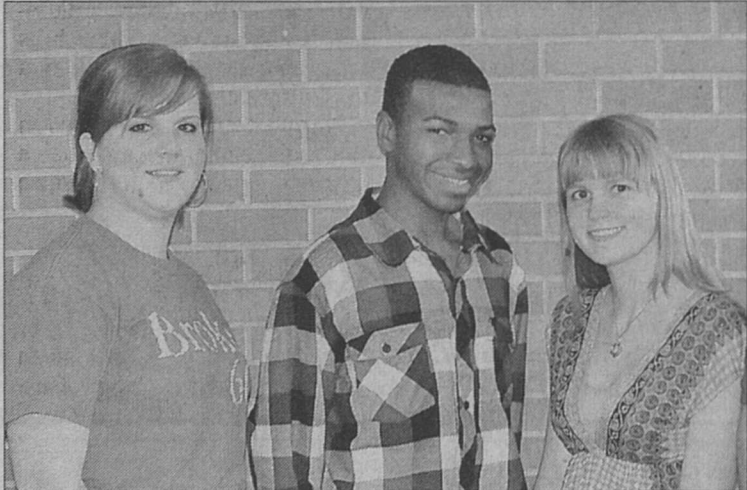

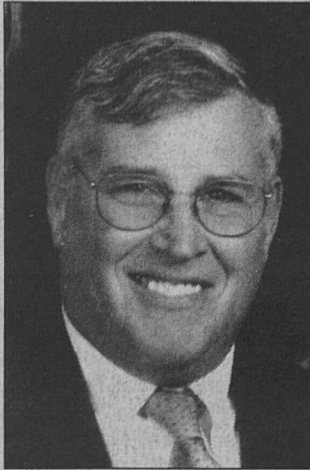
