grant. The low bidder was JTR Constructors out of Houston. The bid of \$266,000 was about \$60,000 under the original construction budget, so the city will be able to add to the job other items outside the original scope of the project, which was to replace diffusers and build a bridge to access the diffusers. Anything added to the project will be determined by needs at the wastewater treatment facility.

Briefly discussed the animal ordinance. Council did not discuss any changes to be made.

Doug Schwemm addressed council during the public comments portion of the meeting saying that he thought the clean-up day associated with the Texas Trash Off was very successful. He said that the effort showed that many people care about the condition of the city. He also said that if the city needs to change some ordinances to help get the city cleaned, then they should get that done.

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
