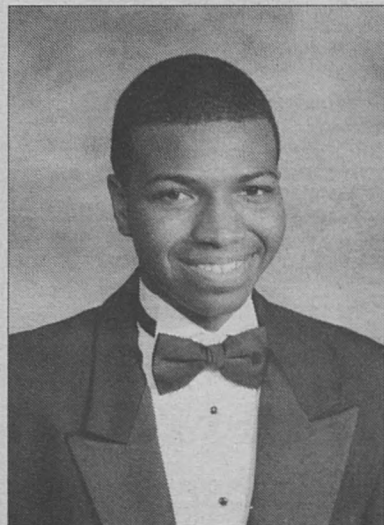


Livestock Show Exhibitor, Colorado County Fair Exhibitor, Honor Roll and Honor Graduate.

Her future plans are to attend Texas A&M University this fall and major in Allied Health. She then plans to attend graduate school to become a Physician Assistant.



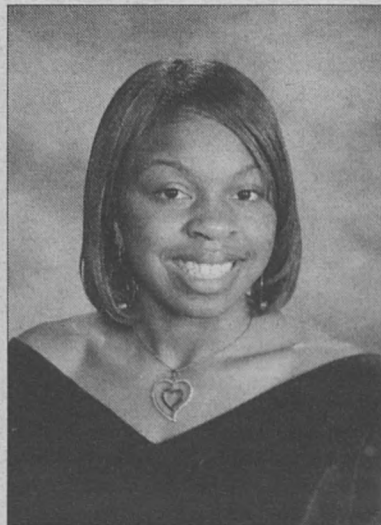
Dillan O'Neal Sanford

She will also be in National Honor Society.

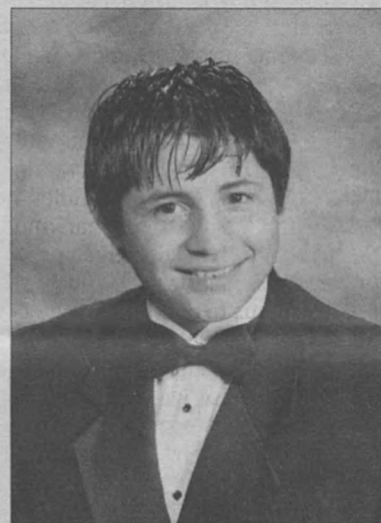

He plans to attend junior college for a short period of time, and then transfer to a university to continue studying and performing music.



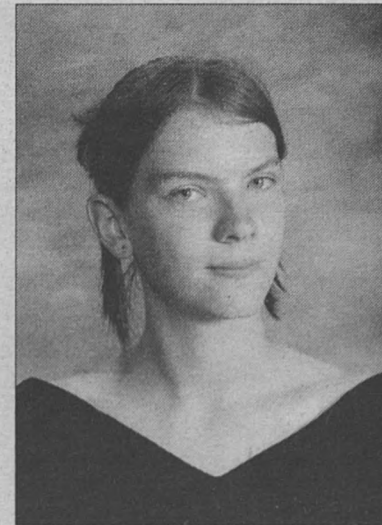
Alan Arellano

Alan plans to attend the University of Texas in San Antonio to major in Electrical Engineering.

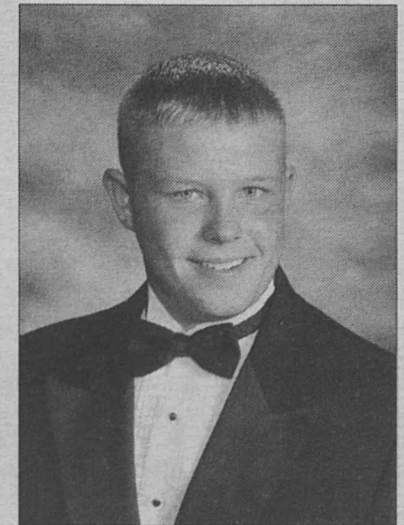


Brittani Bartlett

Chad has been a member of the FFA all four years of high school, serving as secretary and treasurer the last two years.

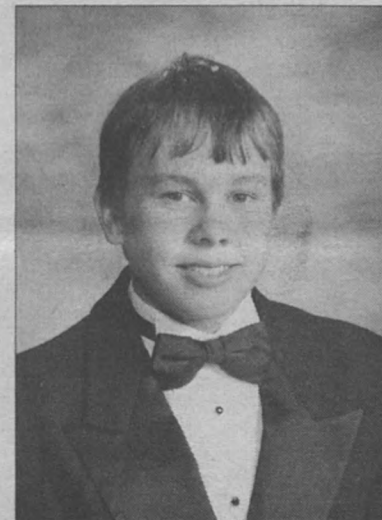
He plans on going to Wharton County Junior College to become a firefighter and certified Paramedic.

La'Markus plans to study Criminal Justice at Navarro Junior College.

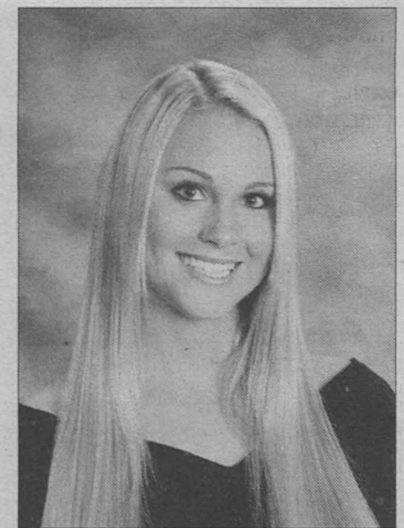


Trey Benton
