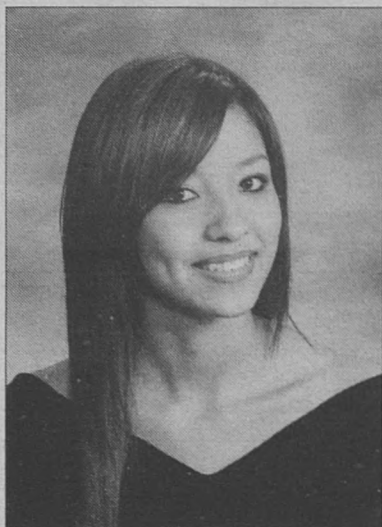


Alex Cardenas

High School has been such an exciting and fun learning experience and has gotten her very far. Being the first in her family to graduate is the best part.

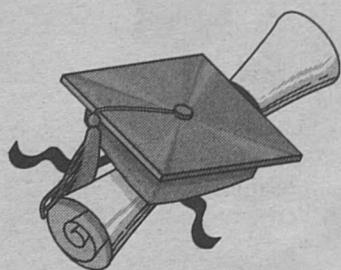
Bianca's future plans are to attend WCJC to study EMS but also working around it to continue her cosmetology.

His greatest accomplishment in school was passing all of his TAKS tests and graduating!

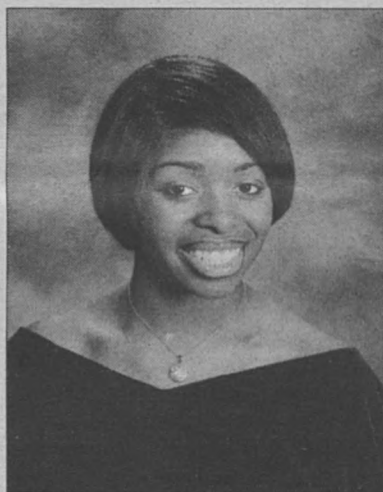
Johnny will be going to Wharton County Junior College for two years. Then he plans to transfer to a four year college and become a History teacher.

Her favorite memory/accomplishment was winning Most Outspoken Female of the senior class.

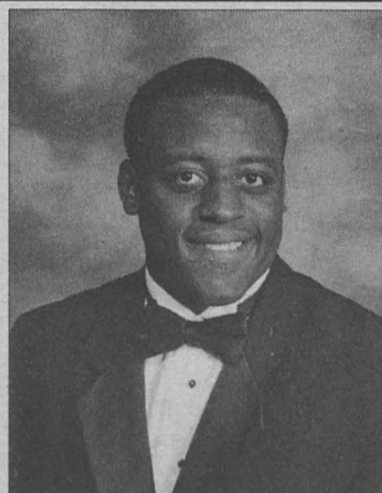
Valencia plans to attend Blinn College in the spring of 2011.

...is the son of Terry and Kenneth Dorsey.

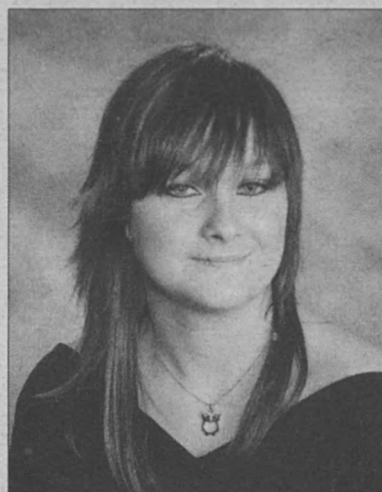

He would also like to take this opportunity to thank Grandma Bobbie Pipkins for everything she's done for him.

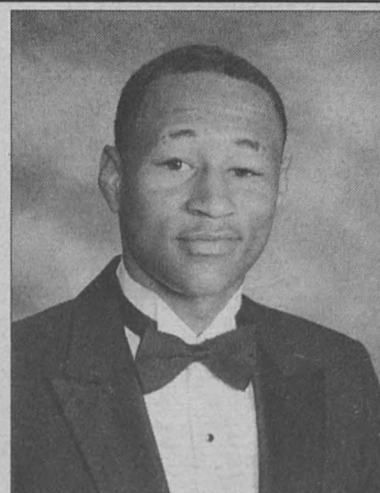
**Rachel Drlik**

She was also in the drama club's presentation of "Treasure Island."

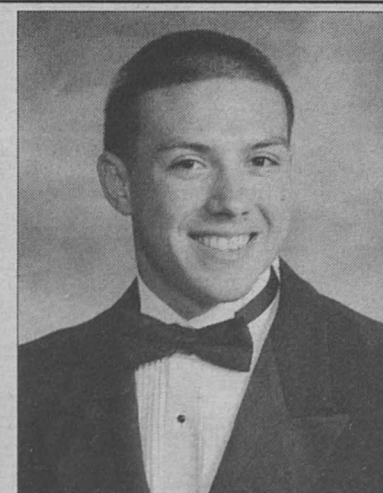
Rachel plans to attend Wharton County Junior College.

His greatest accomplishment was passing all the TAKS tests.

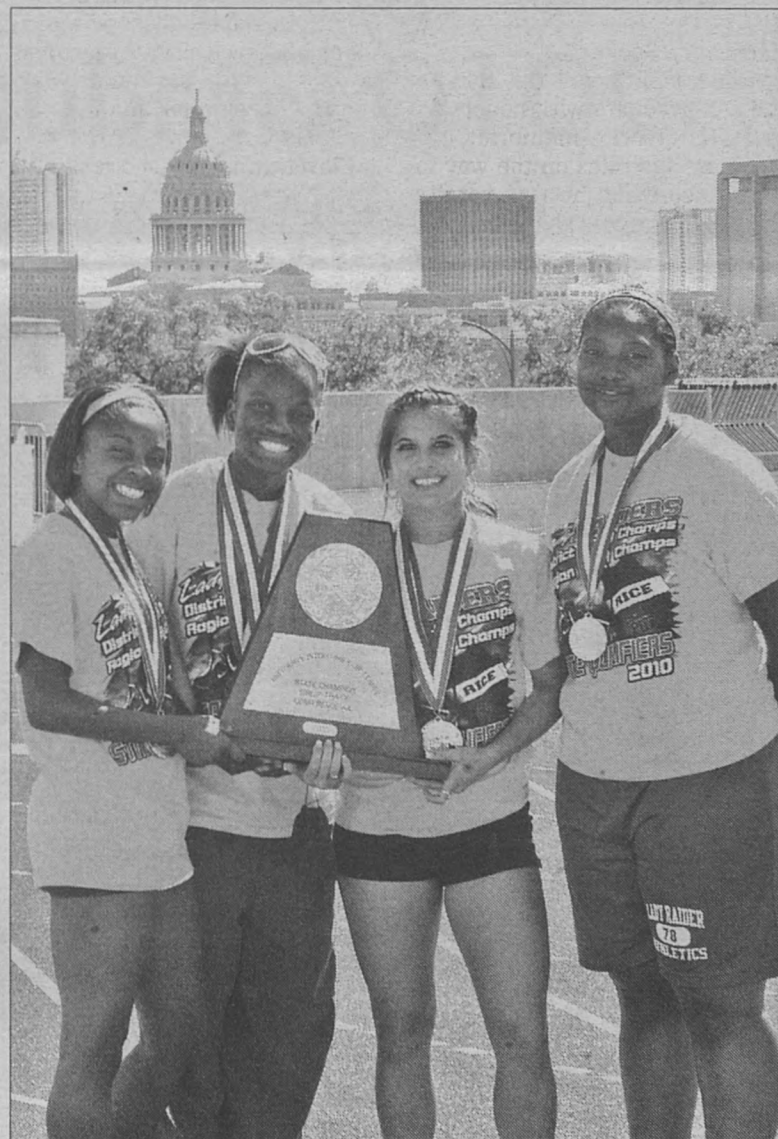
Kevin will attend WCJC and major in Computer Science.
