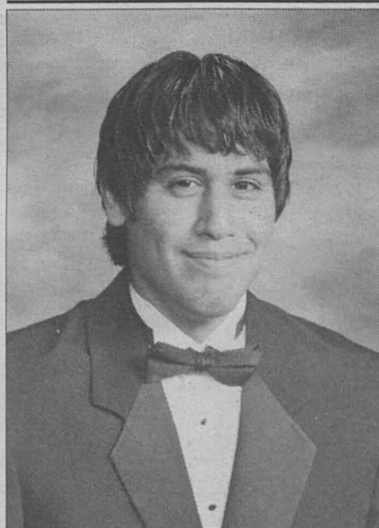




Jesus Javier Leal

Juan plans on attending WCJC for Engineering Design and he will then pursue a career in that field.

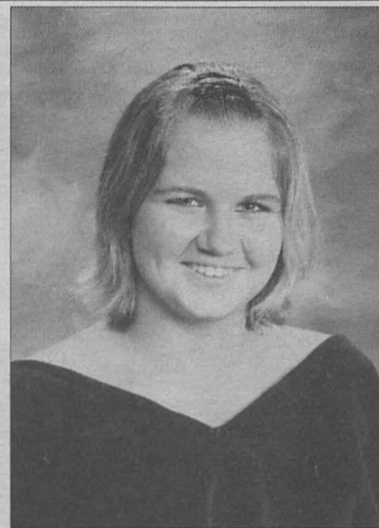


Casey Mayfield

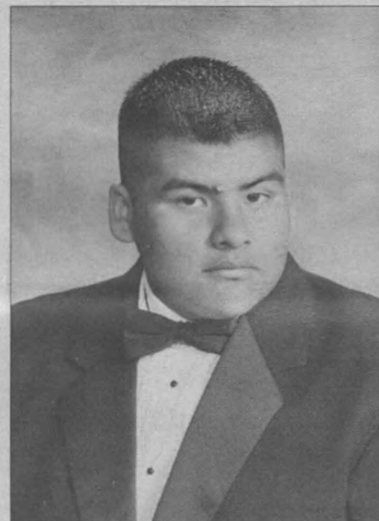


Jennifer McDonald

She plans to attend WCJC to study Nursing to become a Pediatric Nurse.

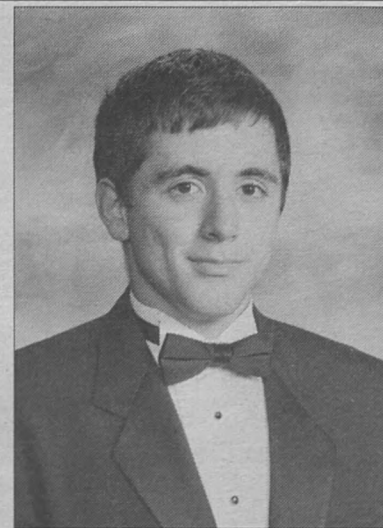


Jairo Mendoza

Jairo plans on attending UTI to study Diesel Mechanics.

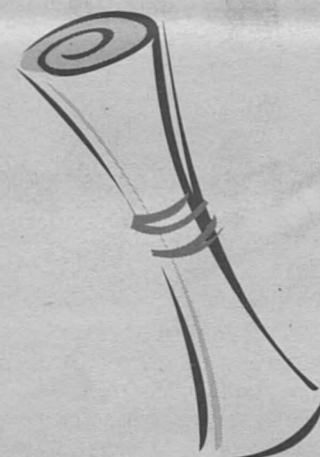


Kody Lee Miller

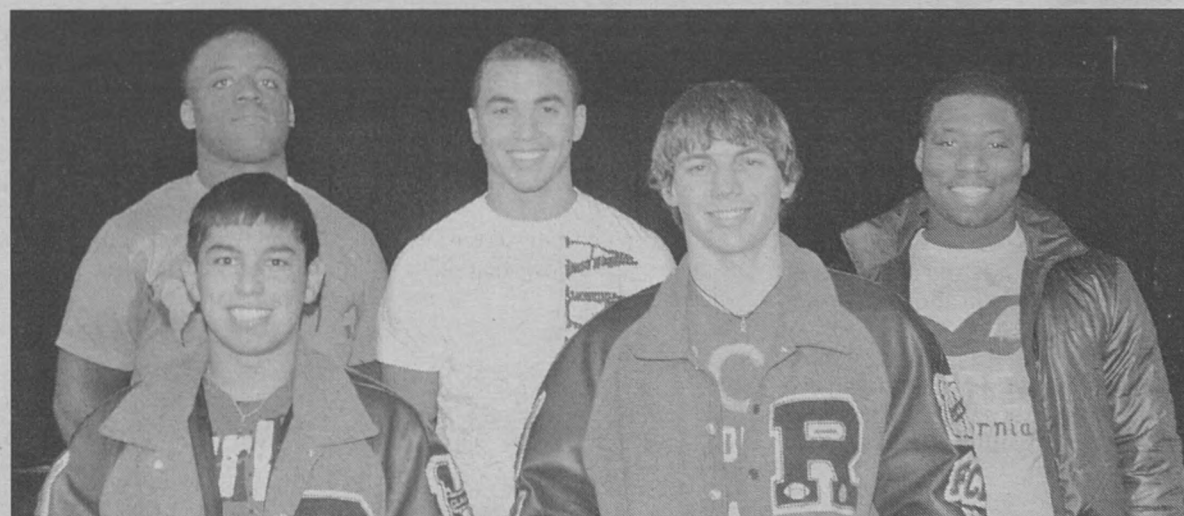
