#### Exhibit To Dallas Fair.

Eagle Lake, Tex., Oct. 17.—An exhibit of products in charge of M. C. Yates has been sent to the Dallas Fair from Colorado county consisting of rice, both rough and finished; ribbon cane and its products from Eagle Lake; canned vegetables and wines from Bernardo, also a built-up platte of Columbus and the Colorado River, showing the town in miniature, and both east and west bridges of the county. It also shows the east and west bridges of the Galveston, Harrisburg and San Antonio Railroad and a miniature dam and the prospective possibilities of the power plant that could be installed on the Colorado River. The power that can be delivered from such a plant is estimated at 4800 horsepower.
